



Make Your Own Toilet Roll Whale

You will need:

- A Toilet Roll Inner tube
- Paper or card (blue or white to paint)
- Paint, paintbrush, pot
- Marker Pen
- Glue
- Scissors
- Messy apron



Squish your toilet roll flat to make it easier to draw on.

Draw a rounded front and an S shape at the back (see picture)



Ask an adult to help you with scissors and cutting out

Cut around the marked section of your toilet roll



Make sure you keep the extra bits as one of them makes up the tail fluke of your whale



Give your toilet roll and tail section a coat of paint and leave it to dry.



Take a strip of blue paper and cut small strips into it to about $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way across the width. Don't cut right to the end.

Roll the paper around a pen to curl it

Glue along the uncut edge and roll lengthways to form the spout

Glue the tail fluke to the tail end of the toilet roll.

With the marker pen, draw some eyes and a smiley face



Make a small hole in the top of your whale

Add your water spout

Now, give your whale a name!

Take a look at the other eggbox and toilet roll sea-life characters you can make. You could draw or write a story about them. Have fun!
